Career Guidance and Subject Choice Assessment

A career assessment is a tool used to assist students and adults in making an informed career decision.

When you come for a career guidance, you will complete a personality, interest, strengths, and values assessment. These assessments help give a better understanding of who you are which in turn gives an indication of which career fields would be a better fit for you. This increases the likelihood of successful completion of your studies and a career which you will enjoy.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Career assessment

Grade 11 and 12 students, as well as post—matric adults. Consists of: a personality, interest, aptitude and values assessment. Approximately 5 hours to complete.

Subject choice assessment

Grade 9 students in the process of choosing their subjects for grade 10. Consists of: a personality, and an interest assessment. Approximately 1 hour to complete.

Career development assessment

This assessment is for mid-career adults. Consists of personality, career interest, and values assessment. Approximately 2 hours to complete.

Feedback

Discussion of assessments completed and the results thereof. Up to an 1-hour.

Report

A comprehensive report based on the assessments completed, results, and options discussed. This can be taken home for future reference.
